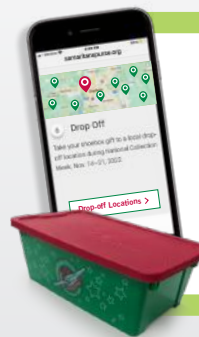

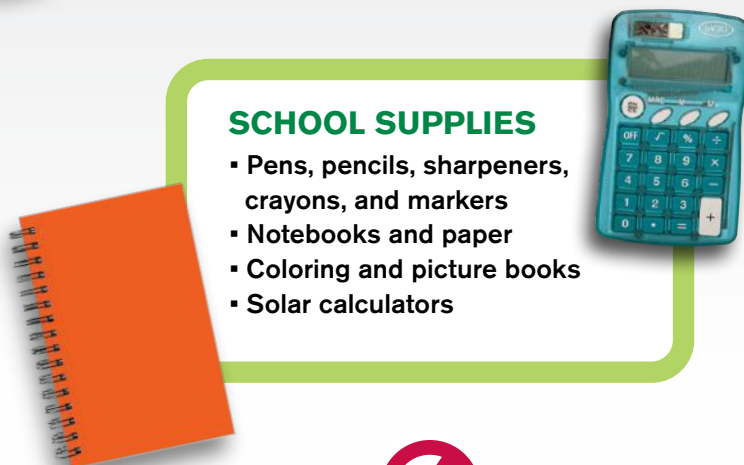

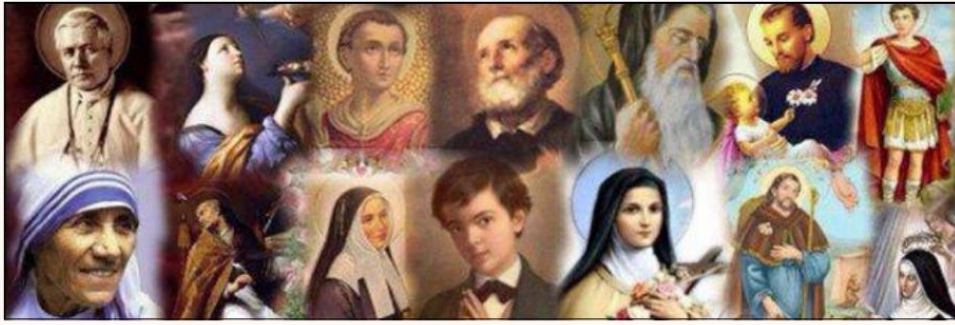

Our November Saints



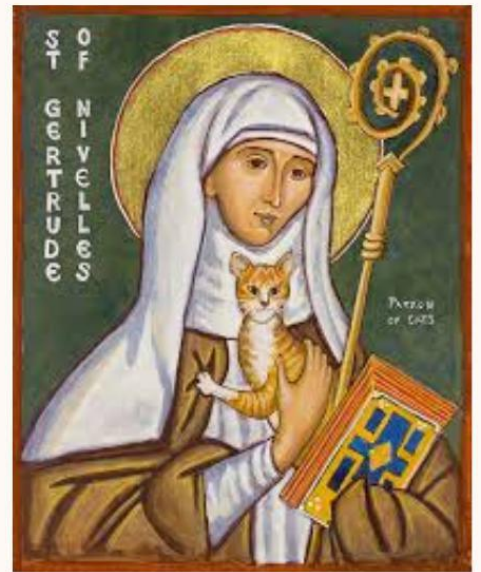
St. Elizabeth of Hungary

A Hungarian princess who became a symbol of Christian charity, known for her work with the poor and sick after becoming a widow. After her marriage to Landgrave Louis IV of Thuringia at age 14, she dedicated herself to charity, inspired by Franciscan ideals. Following Louis's death in 1227, she used her dowry to build a hospital and serve the needy until her own death at 24, after which she was swiftly canonized in 1235. She is revered as the patron saint of nurses, the poor, Catholic charities, and is also associated with bakers and brides.



St. Catherine Laboure

A French nun who in 1830 experienced visions of the Virgin Mary at the Daughters of Charity convent, leading to the creation of the Miraculous Medal. Born in 1806 and dying in 1876, she lived a life of humble service, first as a child caring for her family after her mother's death, and then for 46 years as a Sister of Charity, caring for the elderly and sick. Her body was found incorrupt after her death and is now displayed in Paris.



St. Gertrude the Great

A German Benedictine nun and mystic who became a profound spiritual writer and theological figure. After a transformative mystical vision in 1281, she experienced a deep, personal union with Christ, particularly focusing on the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Awarded the title "the Great" by Pope Benedict XIV for her spiritual depth, she is also known as a patron of the holy souls in purgatory.
